HONOLULU, Aug. 29, 2019 – Enjoy food trucks, entertainment, keiki activities, and more at the first-ever Ka Piko festival, showcasing the community of Waimānalo.

“Ka Piko: Celebrating Waimānalo” takes place 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 7, at Sea Life Park (41-202 Kalanianaʻole Highway #7). The family-friendly event, presented by the nonprofit Nāpuʻuomalei, will highlight the unique qualities of the Waimānalo ahupuaʻa through food, culture and education.

Hawaiian musical performances by **Nā Hoa** (Keoni Souza, Ikaika Blackburn, and Halehaku Seabury-Akaka), **Sean Naʻauao**, **Kulāiwi** (Kawika Kahiapo, Lehua Kalima, and Shawn Pimental), and **Waipuna** (Kale Hannahs, Matthew Sproat, and David Kamakahi). The community-driven event also features a Farmer’s Market, specialty merchandise, food booths, educational activities for keiki, crafts, and more.

Mālama Honua Public Charter School students will perform the opening protocol at the festival, Students of Ke Kula Kaiapuni ʻo Waimānalo ma Blanche Pope, Waimanalo’s first Hawaiian Immersion School, are scheduled to perform oli and mele during the Ka Piko program.
