

Hawai'i Home Energy Assistance Program (H-HEAP)



H-HEAP provides utility assistance to households through a one-time payment per program year

- Energy Credit (EC) assists households in need of financial help for their utilities with applications accepted June 3 – 28
- Energy Crisis Intervention (ECI) assists households facing disconnection due to outstanding balances with applications accepted year-round
- Applicants may be eligible if at least one household member receives Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits

7 required documents

1. **Picture Identification (ID)** – All adults over 18 years old in household
2. **Citizenship** – Documents for all household members (birth certificate, passport, permanent resident alien card, etc.)
3. **Social Security Number (SSN)** – Documents for all household members over 1 year old (SSN card, documents with full SSN listed, etc.)
4. **Proof of Residence** – Rental/lease agreement, rent subsidy letter, etc.)
5. **Utility Bill** – Current bill showing usage at current resident address
6. **Proof of Income** – Most recent documents for every household members' income from January 1 – present day (paystub, SS/SSI, child support, unemployment, veteran's benefits, foster care, adoption, insurance settlements, alimony, etc.)
7. **Signature** – All adults over 18 years old in household
