Energy Crisis Intervention

Assists households in crisis who will be disconnected.



Applications accepted year-round

Maximum \$650 in assistance per household

Energy Credit

Assists households not in crisis, but who need assistance.

- Applications accepted June 1-30
- Payment amounts vary

CATHOLIC CHARITIES HAWAI'I (O'AHU)

Housing Placement Program (HPP):

For families with minors at risk of homelessness or homeless transitioning to housing.

- Household income at or below 250% Federal Poverty Level**
- Open and accepting applications

) To apply, call (808) 521-4357

Supportive Services for Veterans:

For low-income veterans at risk of homelessness only.

- Maximum of 10 months assistance in a 2 year period, no more than 6 months assistance in a 12 month period
- For extremely low-income veterans with household income at or below 30% AMI*, maximum of 12 months assistance in a 2 year period, 9 months assistance in any 12 month period
- Open and accepting applications
