NOTICES TO CUSTOMERS

Notices from the Company to a customer shall be given in writing when written notice is specifically provided for in the tariff and shall usually be given in writing in all other cases; provided however, in emergencies the Company may give oral notice.

NOTICES FROM CUSTOMERS

Notices from a customer to the Company may be given by written communication mailed to a Company business office. Notices from a customer to the $\frac{1}{2}$ Company may also be given orally by the customer or his authorized agent except when written notice is specifically required by the tariff.
