RULE 17

Energy Audits

Energy audits performed by the Company which are required by Federal or State regulations will be paid for directly by customer according to the following fee schedule:

A. Federal Residential Conservation Service (RCS) Program

- 1. The charge for the energy audit to an eligible customer shall be the actual cost of the audit (not to exceed \$15.00) per residential building.
- 2. Definitions for the terms "eligible customer" and "residential building" for the RCS program are cited in Federal Register, Vol. 47, pp. 27752-27803, June 25, 1982.

B. Federal Commercial and Apartment Conservation Service (CACS) Program

- 1. The charge for the energy audit to an eligible customer shall be the actual cost of the audit (not to exceed \$15.00) per residential apartment unit in an apartment building.
- 2. The cost of the energy audit for an eligible customer's small commercial building shall be \$224.00 per audit.
- 3. Definitions for the terms "eligible customer", "apartment building", and "commercial building" for the CACS program are cited in Federal Register, Vol. 48, pp. 49622-49650, October 26, 1983.
